Reading Recertification Requirements 2024-25

Beginning July 1, 2024, as per Section 1012.585(3)(f) F.S., applicants requesting renewal or reinstatement of a Florida professional certificate with one or more of the following coverages [elementary education (k-6), preK/primary education (prek-3), elementary education (1-6), primary education (k-3), English (1-6), middle grades English (5-9), middle grades integrated curriculum (5-9), English (6-12), reading (k-12), reading endorsement, ESOL (k-12) and/or exceptional student education (k-12)] must earn at least two (2) semester hours of college credit or the equivalent 40 in-service points in the use of explicit, systematic and sequential approaches to reading instruction, developing phonemic awareness and implementing multisensory intervention strategies. Documentation of reading credit completion must be submitted to the PL Department for review. Participants can self-register/enroll for up to five reading competency courses. Create a username and password. Use your district email during account creation. Each course is worth 60 points/hours. A course should last about 15 weeks. Participants cannot repeat a course if already submitted. Upon successful completion, email the final certificate to Cheryl Cole. Forty hours can be used for the current certificate validity period and twenty hours can be banked for the next validity period.
