SWD Recertification Requirements 2024-25

Beginning July 1, 2014, applicants requesting renewal or reinstatement of a Florida professional certificate must earn at least one (1) semester hour of college credit or the equivalent 20 in-service points of training in the instruction of students with disabilities (SWD). Documentation of SWD credit completion must be submitted to the PD Department for review.
